MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING MONDAY –OCTOBER 5, 2009 – 2:00 P.M. –

CALL TO ORDER

Chair Shane Idland called the meeting to order at 2:09 p.m., with the following citizen members present: James Dvorak and Sandy Idland. Staff members present included Scott Harter and Janel Chapman. Citizens present: None.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Jim Dvorak indicated that we needed to add that the RFPS for curb cuts were being reviewed and that the Mobility Study was to be copied and folded. A motion was made Jim Dvorak, seconded by Sandy Idland, and carried to approve the minutes of December 15, 2008, as amended.

EMERGENCY ITEMS

CITIZEN INPUT

REPORT ON CURRENT PROJECTS WITH ADA COMPONENTS

City Engineer Harter reported that an overlay project on Forbes Street from Martin Street to Clearlake Avenue will be done with some of the federal economic stimulus funding. There will be ADA accessible ramps on every corner.

There is a project at 562 South Main Street, and it will probably go out to bid in the next couple of weeks. This is a redevelopment project that will have ADA components.

A new sidewalk is being put in at Martin and Forbes Street. This is being done through Redevelopment.

The committee has some concerns regarding a few businesses that do not have ADA accessible parking.

Curb cutouts on South Main Street still need to be addressed. Scott said that this project slipped through the cracks when the City began chasing the economic stimulus dollars. This can be brought up again and bids can probably go out in November. The project will be weather-permitting.

The South Main Street drainage project from Helms Petroleum to K-mart has been done. There is still a small area near LaSalle's Plumbing.

The Forbes Creek trail has been completed at Westside Park. This is a paved trail that is ADA accessible.

REPORT ON BUDGET FOR ADA PROJECTS

The Council carried over the \$38,000 still left for ADA projects. An additional \$30,000 was approved through redevelopment for ADA projects. Janel will send out a map of the redevelopment area to the committee members.

Meetings for the coming year were scheduled.
