## **MINUTES**

### **REGULAR MEETING MONDAY –JUNE 14, 2010 – 3:00 P.M. –**

#### **CALL TO ORDER**

Chair Shane Idland called the meeting to order at 3:01 p.m. Committee members present included James Dvorak and Sandy Idland. Staff members present included Scott Harter and Janel Chapman. Also present were Laura Littrell and Vicki Cole.

#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

A motion was made by Jim Dvorak, seconded by Sandy Idland, and carried to approve the minutes of October 5, 2009, December 7, 2009, and February 1, 2010.

#### **EMERGENCY ITEMS**

There were no emergency items.

#### **CITIZEN INPUT**

There was no citizen input.

#### **REPORT ON CURRENT PROJECTS WITH ADA COMPONENTS**

City Engineer Harter gave a report on current projects within the City. Shane Idland and Jim Dvorak are looking around town to see what else needs to be done. They suggested that the City take a look at better access to the Senior Center, including the sidewalk and building entries.

There has been some trouble with the design engineer for the Safe Routes to School Project.

#### **MOBILITY STUDY**

James Dvorak reported that he has looked at the surveys. The main areas of concern seem to be South Main Street, Eleventh Street, Armstrong Street, and Forbes Street. At the next meeting, we will go over the results of the survey.

#### **LETTER FROM LAKEPORT CHRISTIAN CENTER**

A letter was received from the Lakeport Christian Center regarding putting in an accessible curb at the corner of South Forbes and C Streets. Shane Idland indicated that he would take a look at this area and suggested that maybe this could be funded with Redevelopment Agency monies. Scott will try to find out the number of children who are attending the pre-school on that street and how many parishioners the church has.

**OTHER ITEMS OF INFORMATION OR DISCUSSION ON WHICH NO FORMAL MOTION(S) SHALL BE PROPOSED**

Discussion was held regarding First Street between Forbes and High Streets.

The City is still working on its 2010/11 Budget. City Engineer Harter will look into what funding will be available for ADA.

Discussion was held regarding crosswalks, and the committee questioned whether Redevelopment Agency monies can be used for this.

Vicki asked about plans to make Eleventh Street more accessible. There has been a complaint filed against CalTrans, and they have agreed to allocate \$1.1 billion to relocate telephone poles in the sidewalks. Shane will look to see if Eleventh Street might qualify to be added to the list.

Future meetings will be held on August 2, 2010, October 4, 2010, and December 6, 2010.

There being no further business, Chair Shane Idland adjourned the meeting at 3:47 p.m.
