MINUTES

REGULAR MEETING MONDAY –OCTOBER 25, 2010 – 3:00 P.M. –

CALL TO ORDER

REPORT ON CURRENT PROJECTS WITH ADA COMPONENTS

City Engineer Harter gave a report on current projects within the City. The Performance European Project is wrapping up. In addition to the curb cutouts on the Performance European block, one was also done on the opposing side of the street.

The Notice of Completion for the Forbes Street Project will be recorded today.

Seven proposals were received for the infill project on Main Street to include areas “between” other projects where the streets and sidewalks need to be upgraded. The Consultant Selection Board will meet November 4 to select who will design the improvements within the corridor from Campbell Lane to Clearlake Avenue. These projects will then be done as funding arises to do them.

A Roundabout will be put at the South Main Street/Lakeport Boulevard intersection. This will address several problems in that area. Funding is being sought to complete this project.

CALTRANS GRIEVANCE

City Engineer Harter reported that CalTrans asked for and was provided additional information. We are waiting to hear from them.

OTHER ITEMS OF INFORMATION OR DISCUSSION ON WHICH NO FORMAL MOTION(S) SHALL BE PROPOSED

Shane Idland reported that Lake Transit is putting in 22 new bus shelters throughout the County.

The project at Martin and Bevins Street has been stalled as the City did not receive the HOME Grant that they were hoping for.
