

## ORDINANCE NO. 817 (2002)

### AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKEPORT PROHIBITING BURNING WITHIN CITY LIMITS

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Chapter 8.11 Outside Burning is added to the Lakeport Municipal Code to read as follows:

#### Chapter 8.11 Outside Burning

Section 8.11.010 Prohibition of All Burning Within Incorporated City Limits.  
Outside burning of all kinds within the incorporated limits of the City of Lakeport is prohibited. The following exceptions shall apply:

- 1) cooking of food products using an appropriate barbecue on public or private property, and
- 2) Fire Department/District training exercises that include burning of a building or other structure when under the supervision of Fire Chief or his/her designee, and in compliance with applicable air pollution regulations.

Violation of this section shall constitute an infraction and shall be punishable in accordance with Section 1.08.010 C. of this Code.

#### **Section 2. Severability.**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed this and each section, subsection, phrase or clause thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, phrase or clauses be declared unconstitutional on their face or as applied.

#### **Section 3. Effective Date.**

This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after the date of adoption.


**Section 4. Posting/Advertising**
