

CITY OF LAKEPORT PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION MINUTES

Tuesday, June 16, 2015



Call to Order & Roll Call: The meeting of the City of Lakeport Parks and Recreation Commission was called to order at 5:10 pm, with all members present.

Doug Grider presented concept of footprint path through downtown area and Library Park. Commission members discussed ideas of extending walking path to 1.0-1.5 miles in length. Several path options were considered. Discussion included what the costs would be to establish a path through the Natural High school property. Commission discussed surface options.

Suzanne Russel moved and *Suzanne Lyons* seconded: to adopt Mr. Grider's footprint stencil for the trail markers.

Suzanne Lyons moved and Ann Blue seconded the motion to: Direct staff to meet with City Manager and explore with Lakeport Unified School District the feasibility of establishing a semi-permanent trail through the school district's Natural High property.

Commissioners agreed to come to next regularly scheduled Park Commission meeting with alternative path options through the downtown district and neighboring streets. This item is to be agenized.

Discussion of the \$5,000 Wellness Grant expenditure and potential extension of walking path at Westside Community park was tabled to the next commission meeting.
