The Lakeport Police Department, Division of Animal Control will be mailing out dog licensing bills in the next few weeks.

The LPD took over licensing for the City of Lakeport from the Lake County Animal Care and Control in late 2008. We currently have approximately 400 licensed dogs in our City.

This year, for the first time, the license tags will be permanent. While you will still be billed on a yearly basis, you will no longer have to change tags. All licenses are valid from January 1 through December 31 of each year.

If you live in the City of Lakeport and have a dog, but do not receive a bill, please call the LPD at 263-5491 and we will be happy to send a license form to you. Or you can email us at petlicensing@lakeportpolice.org and we will email a form to you.

All bills are due no later than February 28, 2010. A late fee of \$15.00 will be assessed after that date. Fees for licensing have remained the same this year: \$10.00 for altered dogs and \$50.00 for unaltered dogs. We do have discounted rates for senior citizens, seeing-eye dogs, AKA registered, breeding, herding and working dogs. All rates are the same as Lake County Animal Care and Control.
