Officers from the Lakeport Police Department assist with security during nursing strike at Sutter Lakeside Hospital

A representative from the Sutter Lakeside Hospital contacted Lakeport Police staff late Tuesday afternoon seeking assistance with security concerns for the planned nurses' strike by member of the California Nurses Association on 9-22-11. Sutter Lakeside Hospital requested to contract for two Lakeport Police Officers to be present at the main entrance of the hospital off Hill Rd. from 0700 hrs. to 1900 hrs. Sutter Lakeside Hospital agreed to reimburse the city of Lakeport for all overtime costs incurred. The Lakeport Police Department agreed to the contract after consulting with the Lake County Sheriffs Office regarding the event.

The mission of the Lakeport Police Officers will be the safety of all parties involved and to remain impartial.
